Entering his fifth year as head coach...formerly served nine years as assistant head coach and offensive line coach under Chuck Lyon...has been with COC since the reinstatement of the football program in 1998...in his three seasons as head coach, Tujague has led the team to a 33-14 record...garnered coach of the year honors in 2007 and 2008... tutored more than 25 student-athletes who received scholarships to four-year universities, including three Community College All-America honorees...before joining the Cougars, coached at Chabot and the University of Redlands...while at Redlands, the Bulldogs won two Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Championships...played offensive lineman at BYU, where his teams won three Western Athletic Conference titles...earned All-conference honors while blocking for Heisman Trophy winner Ty Detmer...prior to BYU, played at Chabot and was named an All-America offensive lineman...received a bachelor's in recreation management from BYU and a master's in educational counseling from the University of Redlands...

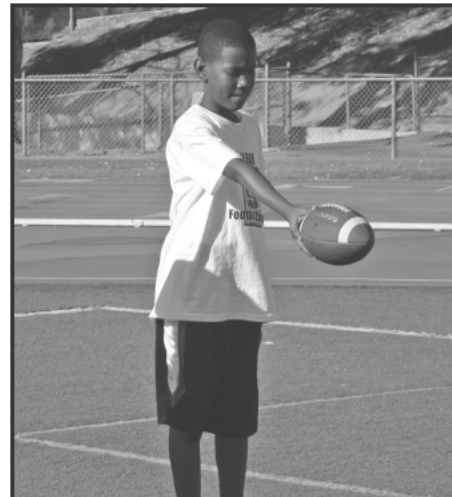


Join Cougar head coach Garrett Tujague and other coaches and players from the **College of Canyons Football Program** in a thrilling football skills summer camp! Designed for players in grades 1 through 8, this **non-contact** camp will help players increase their skills in every area of football, including:

Offense and Defense • Passing, Rushing, Catching • Blocking • Kicking and Punting • and Much More!

Whether you're just looking to increase your skills or are looking to learn how to play the game at its basic level, this camp has something for you! Individualized attention will be available as the coaching staff puts each camper through the stations in beautiful Cougar Stadium. Cougar Stadium was retrofitted in 2003 with a new FieldTurf playing field, the same turf now being used by many teams in the National Football League, including the Seattle Seahawks and St. Louis Rams.

The **College of the Canyons Cougars** finished 14-0 in the 2004 season and is the only team in the history of California Community College football to ever finish a season with a 14-0 mark. The Cougars were named National Champions, won the State Championship, and are seven-time conference champions. In the past 10 years, more than 100 players have earned scholarships to Division I schools from College of the Canyons, including a school record 26 players in 2006. In the past seven years, eight former Cougars have been taken in the NFL Draft: Defensive Lineman **Jason Pierre-Paul** (COC '07/USF) - 1st Round, New York Giants, 2010; Safety **Troy Nolan** (COC '04-'05/ASU) - 7th Round, Houston Texans, 2009; Defensive Back **Justin Tryon** (COC '04-'05/ASU) - 4th Round, Washington Redskins, 2008; Linebacker **Joey LaRocque** (COC '04-'05/OSU) - 7th Round, Chicago Bears, 2008; Offensive Lineman **Domata Peko** (COC '02-'03/MSU) - 4th Round, Cincinnati Bengals, 2004; Running back **J.J. Arrington** (COC '01-'02/Cal) - 2nd Round, Arizona Cardinals, 2004; Defensive Lineman **Jonathan Fanene** (COC '00-'01/Utah) - 7th Round, Cincinnati Bengals 2004; Offensive Lineman **Isaac Sopoaga** (COC '00-'01/Hawaii) - 4th Round, San Francisco 49ers, 2003. In 2009 COC had its first player take part in the Super Bowl when former Arizona Cardinal **J.J. Arrington** took the field in Tampa Bay. More than 20 players from the past two seasons received scholarships to Division I universities, including OL **Louiszell Alexander** (Syracuse); OL **Joe Evinger** (Louisville); DB **Josh Gibbs** (Kentucky); FB **Evan Harrington** (Colorado); OL **Randy Horton** (Nevada); WR **Mychal Rivera** (Tennessee).
